بنا به تشخیص این کتاب، یادداشت کون «رونوشت پروندهٔ پزشکی شمارهٔ ۲۱۵۰۲ 'درمانگاه کانتونالِ مونسترلینگن' است که پروندهٔ بیمار زنی به نام پائولا اف.جی، متولد ۳۰ آوریل ۱۹۰۷، است». در ماه مارس ۲۰۲۰ گزارش تاریخنگاران دانشگاه زوریخ مدعی شد کون (که، علاوه بر ایمی پرامین، ترکیبات بسیار دیگری را آزمایش کرده بود) موفق نشده بود از مقتضیات روش شناختی معمولی آن زمان پیروی کند، مثلاً داروهایی را برای بیماران تجویز کرده بود که تمام مراحل آزمایشی اولیه را پشت سر نگذاشته بودند. به علاوه، کون چندان در قیدوبند تاریخ شروع و پایان کارآزمایی های بالینی نبود.
